NEW PROJECTS AWARDED TO DIGGS

Greater Hartford Transit District - Hartford, CT

Diggs Construction, LLC was selected to serve as the design builder of this \$910,000 roof and ceiling system project at the historic Union Station in downtown Hartford, CT. Designed by our Senior Project Manager Shane Hanley, this project involves erecting a steel frame and metal decking enclosure over approximately 15,000 SF of an elevated idle train track. Below the elevated track is a pedestrian walkway that allows access to the facility's 24 commercial bus gates which will be protected from the elements upon completion of the project. As part of the project, a new Armstrong Metalworks™ exterior ceiling system will be installed above the walkway and will include a lighting upgrade to all new drop in LED light fixtures. Matt Leone will serve as the Superintendent on this project.

Stop & Shop Store #0608 - Colchester, CT

Diggs was selected to serve as the General Contractor for the renovation and upgrades to a 51,000 SF Stop & Shop Supermarket. Upgrades include new frozen food cases, a new compressor room, a new refrigeration system, and updates to the sales floor. All store décor will be updated to the new Stop & Shop guidelines, and both the Natural Food and Floral Departments will be completely remodeled. This \$893,000 project is scheduled to be completed in June of 2012.

CREC Reggio Magnet School - Avon, CT

Diggs will serve as General Contractor for the CREC Reggio Magnet School. This school is owned by the Capitol Region Education Council and will consist of a complete renovation of a 54,000 SF office building. The project has a value of \$1,348,000 and is scheduled for completion in July of 2012.

Glendower/HANH - New Haven, CT

Diggs was selected by Glendower and the Housing Authority of New Haven to serve as Construction Monitor for the Rockview Phase 1 project. This \$194,395 project will include 77 units, ranging from two to four bedroom units. Construction is scheduled to start in September 2012 with an estimated completion date of November 2013.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

Glen Burnie, MD - Diggs Construction, LLC was the General Contractor for the 14,304 SF dialysis center interior fit-out of the DaVita Glen Burnie Dialysis Center project, which consisted of two shared facilities in one location. A Home Training Division included seven offices, reception area, three bathrooms, two training rooms, waiting area, a nurse station and six patient rooms. The second facility was the Clinic Division which encompassed a thirty seat patient care floor with multiple offices, storage rooms, equipment rooms, four bathrooms, waiting area, reception area, conference room, nurses' station, utility rooms, medical prep area and lab prep areas. Alfred Plitt was the Superintendent on this project.

Grand Opening - DaVita Hamden Dialysis Center

On January 10th, DaVita hosted the Grand Opening of their new Hamden, CT location.
